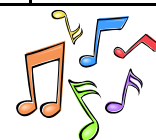

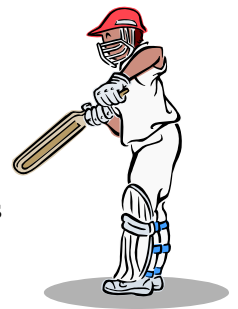


## Elms Lower School Car Park
